Motion was made by Mr. Stiers, which carried 5:0 to adopt the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION CONFIRMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, on October 26, 2012, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia declared a State of Emergency encompassing all of Virginia under the laws of the Commonwealth; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 27, 2012, the Coordinator of Emergency Management declared a local emergency for the County of New Kent; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 30, Article VIII of the New Kent County Code and the Code of Virginia, a local emergency has been declared due to the occurrence of Hurricane Sandy; and

**WHEREAS**, New Kent County was facing a condition of extreme peril to the lives, safety and property of the residents of New Kent County. As a result of this extreme peril, the proclamation of the existence of an emergency is necessary to permit the full powers of the government to deal effectively with this condition of peril; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Virginia Code 44-146.21, the Coordinator of Emergency Management is requesting confirmation of the local emergency from the New Kent County Board of Supervisors;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the New Kent County Board of Supervisors hereby confirms that a local emergency pursuant to Virginia Code 44-146.21, began on October 27, 2012, and may still exist throughout New Kent County, Virginia;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that during the existence of this emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the Director of Emergency Management and the Emergency Management organization and functions of New Kent County shall be those prescribed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the ordinances, resolutions and approved plans of New Kent County in order to mitigate the effects of said emergency.
