**A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE VIRGINIA
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ERECT
“WATCH FOR CHILDREN” SIGNS ON
HOLLY WOODS COURT**


WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the New Kent County Board of Supervisors that there have been close calls involving vehicles traveling along Holly Woods Court (Route 1236) in the Woods at Five Lakes subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that the posting of “Watch for Children” signs at or near the entrance to Holly Woods Court would benefit the safety of the large number of children in the neighborhood and provide appropriate warning to the motoring public; and

WHEREAS, this road is publicly maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation and there are similar signs on other roads in this subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors on this, the 18th day of April, 2012, that the Board does hereby request the Virginia Department of Transportation to erect “Watch for Children” signs at or near the entrance to Holly Woods Court (Route 1236) at the earliest possible time, and that the cost of installation be paid out of New Kent County’s secondary system construction allocation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that representatives of the Virginia Department of Transportation are hereby requested to provide a report to the Board of Supervisors and to the Sheriff giving an approximate date by which the requested signs may be erected.
