Motion was made by Mr. Davis, which carried 5:0 to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION DECLARING A LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2012, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia declared a state of Emergency under the laws of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2012, the Coordinator of Emergency Management has declared a local emergency; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 30, Article VIII of the New Kent County Code and the Code of Virginia a local emergency has been declared due to the occurrence of Unusually Strong Storms on June 29 –30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, New Kent County is facing a condition of extreme peril to the lives, safety and property of the residents of New Kent County. As a result of this extreme peril, the proclamation of the existence of an emergency is necessary to permit the full powers of the government to deal effectively with this condition of peril; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Virginia Code 44-146.21, the Coordinator of Emergency Management is requesting confirmation of the local emergency from the New Kent County Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY CONFIRMED by the Board of Supervisors, New Kent County, Virginia that a local emergency pursuant to Virginia Code 44-146.21, now exists throughout New Kent County, Virginia; and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of this emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the Director of Emergency Management and the Emergency Management organization and functions of New Kent County shall be those prescribed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the ordinances, resolutions and approved plans of New Kent County in order to mitigate the effects of said emergency.
