WHEREAS, Mr. Scott moved to New Kent County in the early 1930s when he married Henrietta Scott, and raised one daughter (deceased); and


WHEREAS, after the passing of Henrietta, he married Iola B. Scott in 1979 and they currently reside in Quinton; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Scott continues to be active in his church and community, and serves on the Deaconate Board of Mount Calvary Baptist Church; and




December 10, 2011, where he stated that he was blessed to see 100 years and felt no aches and pains;


