AVERAGE LAND USE COVER

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Virginia has established a default average land use cover condition for Bay Act localities of 16% impervious cover; and


WHEREAS, this standard is part of the Virginia Stormwater Management Law of 1999; and

WHEREAS, the County of New Kent Department of Community Development has applied an 8% impervious cover based on the land use within the county; and


WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors has recently conducted a review of the 8% impervious cover; and

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors recognizes the need for a policy that can address water quality and promote economic growth;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the New Kent County Board of Supervisors adopt the Virginia Stormwater Management Law of 1999 Chesapeake Bay default average land cover condition value of 16% impervious cover for residential and commercial activity.
