**A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE VIRGINIA
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ERECT
“WATCH FOR CHILDREN” SIGNS ON ROADS IN
THE BROWN SUBDIVISION**

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the New Kent County Board of Supervisors that there have been close calls involving vehicles traveling along Virginia Avenue (Route 669), Brown Avenue (Route 1037), Piper Drive (Route 1036) and Curle Drive (Route 1035) in the Brown subdivision; and


WHEREAS, the Board believes that the posting of “Watch for Children” signs at or near the entrances to these roads would benefit the safety of children in the community and provide appropriate warning to the motoring public; and

WHEREAS, all four roads are publicly maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors on this the 12th day of December, 2011, that the Board does hereby request the Virginia Department of Transportation to erect “Watch for Children” signs at or near the entrances to Virginia Avenue (Route 669), Brown Avenue (Route 1037), Piper Drive (Route 1036) and Curle Drive (Route 1035) at the earliest possible time, and that the cost

of installation be paid out of New Kent County's secondary system construction allocation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that representatives of the Virginia Department of Transportation are hereby requested to provide a report to the Board of Supervisors and to the Sheriff giving an approximate date by which the requested signs may be erected.
