**A RESOLUTION FOR THE APPROVAL
OF THE ADDITION OF TAX MAP PARCELS LISTED BELOW
CURRENTLY OWNED BY THE STOLZ FAMILY TRACT LLC
TO THE DIASCUND CREEK AGRICULTURAL
AND FORESTAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Stolz Family Tract LLC has applied to add the tax map parcels listed in the table below, totaling approximately 1302.96 acres to the Diascund Creek Agricultural and Forestal District; and

WHEREAS, granting this request will increase the acreage of the Diascund Creek Agricultural and Forestal District from approximately 1,588 acres to approximately 2,891 acres; and

WHEREAS, this request is in accordance with state and local laws governing Agricultural and Forestal Districts; and

WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee voted 7:0:1 to forward a favorable recommendation of this application; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission scheduled and conducted a formal and duly advertised public hearing in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Code of Virginia, carefully considering the public comment received; and

WHEREAS, after conducting a duly advertised public hearing in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Code of Virginia voted 10:0:1 to forward the request with a favorable recommendation; and

WHEREAS, this application has been advertised for public hearing before the Board of Supervisors in full accordance with the applicable provisions of the Code of Virginia, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this the 8th day of August, 2011, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors, the addition of the tax map parcels listed below totaling approximately 1302.96 acres to the Diascund Creek Agricultural and Forestal District is hereby approved with the following conditions:




