Motion was made by Mr. Davis, which carried 4:0, to adopt the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE
PROPOSED FREEZE TO THE
LOCAL COMPOSITE INDEX FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011**

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors, in partnership with the New Kent County School Board and the entire community, is committed to providing a high-quality and cost-effective education for all students; and

WHEREAS, New Kent's School Board receives approximately 53% of its funding from the Commonwealth of Virginia, which is based on the Local Composite Index (LCI), the formula used to determine State and Local shares of K-12 education costs; and

WHEREAS, Governor Robert McDonnell has recently recommended unfreezing the Local Composite Index, thereby negatively impacting New Kent County Public Schools by almost \$480,000 less State Education Aid; and

WHEREAS, a total of ninety-three school districts across the State would lose State Education Aid if the proposal to unfreeze the CPI is adopted;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of New Kent County, Virginia, that it joins the New Kent County School Board in its support to continue the freeze to the Local Composite Index for Fiscal Year 2011; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be sent to the County's legislative representatives, the Governor, and Virginia's Superintendent of Public Instruction.
