Motion was made by Mr. Trout, which carried 5:0, to adopt the following resolution:

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL
FOR THE ADDITION OF TAX MAP PARCELS 25-18A, 25-18, 25-12, AND 25-19
TO THE PAMUNKEY FARMS AGRICULTURAL AND FORESTAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Walter J. Hawthorne Jr. and Patricia W. Hawthorne have applied to add tax map parcels, (GPINs #) 25-18A, (K23-3463-3216); 25-18, (K23-2168-3251); 25-12, (K23-0986-4077); and 25-19, (K23-0282-3768), totaling approximately 293 acres to the Pamunkey Farms Agricultural and Forestal District; and

WHEREAS, granting this request will increase the acreage of the Pamunkey Farms Agricultural and Forestal District to approximately 2,900 acres; and

WHEREAS, the realignment and renaming of the current Agricultural and Forestal Districts will be reviewed and, if approved, this request will become a portion of the Cooks Mill Agricultural and Forestal District; and

WHEREAS, this request is in accordance with state and local laws governing Agricultural and Forestal Districts; and


WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee voted 7:0:1 to forward a favorable recommendation of this application; and

WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Planning Commission who, after conducting a duly advertised public hearing in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Code of Virginia, voted 9:0:1 to forward the request with a favorable recommendation; and

WHEREAS, this application has been advertised for public hearing before the Board of Supervisors in full accordance with the applicable provisions of the Code of Virginia.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this the 9th day of August 2010, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors, the addition of tax map parcels, (GPINs); 25-18A, (K23-3463-3216); 25-18, (K23-2168-3251); 25-12, (K23-0986-4077); and 25-19, (K23-0282-3768), consisting of approximately 293 acres, to the Pamunkey Farms Agricultural and Forestal District is hereby approved.
