**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING  
A SPEED STUDY FOR  
OLD RIVER ROAD/STATE ROUTE 608**


**WHEREAS**, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors has received concerns about truck traffic and the safety of travel along Old River Road (State Route 608) from residents of this road; and;

**WHEREAS**, as a result of these concerns, several meetings have been held with residents of this road as well as representatives of the New Kent County Sheriff's Office, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), Basic Construction Company, who uses this road to transport sand extracted from its pit on the road, as well as County staff, to discuss these issues and to try to address the situation; and

**WHEREAS**, many of the concerns expressed by the residents at these meetings involved the speed of trucks and other vehicles traveling this road and the related safety issues and, as VDOT is responsible for setting safe speed limits along secondary roads in Virginia after certain studies are completed, the group attending the meeting requested that the New Kent County Board of Supervisors ask VDOT to examine these matters;


**NOWHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors that VDOT is hereby requested to:

1. Perform a speed study on Old River Road to determine the appropriate safe speed for all vehicles that travel along this road. It is requested that this study be conducted when Basic Construction Company is extracting sand from its facility on this road.
