WHEREAS, New Kent County is undertaking a grant-funded project to establish marked and mapped bicycle routes in and around the County in an effort to promote tourism activities in New Kent; and


WHEREAS, a critical part of the project is to provide a safe path for cyclists between the County Visitor and Commerce Center and the roundabout just north of the Visitor and Commerce Center to avoid an unsafe U-turn along Vineyards Parkway near its interchange with Interstate 64; and

WHEREAS, Life Scout Jonathon M. Gellings volunteered to donate the construction and materials for two bridges across drainage structures along the pathway as his Eagle Scout project allowing the federal and state grant funds used for this project to stretch further; and


