**A RESOLUTION TO DISSOLVE THE JOINT
COMMUNITY POLICY AND MANAGEMENT TEAM
OF NEW KENT COUNTY & CHARLES CITY COUNTY,
AND CREATE A DISTINCT NEW KENT COUNTY
COMMUNITY POLICY AND MANAGEMENT TEAM**


WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors had previously created a joint Community Policy and Management Team (CPMT) with Charles City County, to administer the programs required by the adoption of the Comprehensive Services Act by the Virginia General Assembly, and;

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors has received information from its staff recommending that the County dissolve the joint CPMT and create a distinct New Kent County Community Policy and Management Team to administer the programs required under the Comprehensive Services Act, and;


WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors agrees with the staff recommendation and wishes to create a distinct New Kent County Community Policy and Management Team;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors that the previous action by the Board of October 12, 1992, creating the joint New Kent/Charles City Community Policy and Management Team is hereby rescinded and the New Kent County Community Policy and Management Team is hereby created, effective on and after July 1, 2009, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that New Kent's CPMT shall be comprised of representatives or designees from appropriate departments or agencies, including but not limited to the New Kent Department of Social Services, the Financial Services Department, the Court Services Unit, the New Kent Health Department, the New Kent School Board and/or School System, the Board of Supervisors, and the Community Services Board, as well as a local private provider and a parent representative.
