TO ADD PINE HOLLOW ROAD IN THE
QUAKER ROAD ESTATES SUBDIVISION INTO THE
STATE SYSTEM FOR MAINTENANCE**

WHEREAS, the Resident Administrator for the Sandston residency of the Virginia Department of Transportation has advised the Board that the street listed herein meets the requirements established by the *Subdivision Street Requirements* of the Virginia Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the street listed herein be accepted into the secondary system of state highways for maintenance;



Pine Hollow Road	from Rte 611/Quaker Road to cul-de-sac	0.09 miles	40 ft.


