**A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE VIRGINIA
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ADD
CHEROKEE PINES TRAIL INTO THE STATE SYSTEM
FOR MAINTENANCE**

WHEREAS, Cherokee Pines Trail is shown on plats recorded at plat book 19, page 84 in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of New Kent County; and

WHEREAS, the Resident Administrator for the Sandston residency of the Virginia Department of Transportation has advised the Board that the street listed herein meet the requirements established by the *Subdivision Street Requirements* of the Virginia Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the street listed herein be accepted into the secondary system of state highways for maintenance;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this, the 12th day of November 2008, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors that the Virginia Department of Transportation be, and it is hereby, requested to add the following street to the


secondary system of state highways pursuant to section 33.1-229 of the *Code of Virginia* and the Department's *Subdivision Street Requirements*:

Cherokee Pines Trail	.07 Miles	50'


