**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADDITION
OF TAX MAP PARCEL 7-16 TO THE OLD
DISPATCH AGRICULTURAL AND
FORESTAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Mr. Hartwell Coke, Jr. has applied to add tax map parcel 27-1-9 containing approximately 139 acres to the Old Dispatch Agricultural and Forestal District; and

WHEREAS, granting this request will increase the acreage of the Old Dispatch Agricultural and Forestal District to approximately 1,564 acres; and

WHEREAS, this request is in accordance with state and local laws governing Agricultural and Forestal Districts; and

WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, after conducting a duly advertised public hearing, the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee voted 5:0:1 to recommend approval of this application; and


WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, after conducting a duly advertised public hearing in accordance with the applicable State and County laws governing the AFD program, the Planning Commission voted 8:0:1 to recommend approval of this application; and


WHEREAS, this application has been advertised for public hearing before the Board of Supervisors in full accordance with the applicable provisions of the Code of Virginia,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this, the 11th day of August 2008, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors that the addition of tax map parcel 27-1-9 containing approximately 139 acres to the Old Dispatch Agricultural and Forestal District is hereby approved with the following conditions:

1. The applicant shall work with the Virginia Forestry Department to development a forestry stewardship plan within six (6) months from the date of approval.
