Motion was made by Mr. Tiller, which carried 5:0, to adopt the following resolution:

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION AFD 004-14  
FOR THE ADDITION OF TAX MAP PARCELS  
22-66A, 22-66, 23-41 AND 23-36 TO THE  
PELHAM SWAMP AGRICULTURAL AND FORESTAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Criss Cross Properties has applied to add tax map parcels 22-66A, 22-66, 23-41 and 23-36 totaling 639 acres, of which 547 acres have been identified as agricultural and forestal significant to the Pelham Swamp Agricultural and Forestal District; and

WHEREAS, granting this request will increase the acreage of the Pelham Swamp Agricultural and Forestal District from its current 1,721 acres; and


WHEREAS, this request is in accordance with state and local laws governing Agricultural and Forestal Districts; and

WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, after conducting a duly advertised public hearing, the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee voted 6:0:0 to have applications amended to correct acreage count, and applications were revised by applicant; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission scheduled and conducted a formal and duly advertised public hearing in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Code of Virginia, carefully considering the public comments received and voted 6:0:1 to forward a favorable recommendation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 14th day of October 2014, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors, the proposed agricultural and forestall application for the addition of tax map parcels 22-66A, 22-66, 23-41 and 23-36 containing approximately 639 acres to the Pelham Swamp Agricultural and Forestal District is hereby approved.
