**A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION AFD-005-14
FOR THE ADDITION OF TAX MAP PARCELS 12-27 AND 23-7 TO THE
PAMUNKEY RIVER AGRICULTURAL AND FORESTAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Shuttlewood Farms has applied to add tax map parcels 12-27 and 23-7, totaling approximately 711 acres, or which 613 acres have been identified as agricultural and forestal significant to the Pamunkey River Agricultural and Forestal District; and

WHEREAS, granting this request will increase the acreage of the Pamunkey River Agricultural and Forestal District from its 2013 acres of 7,564; and

WHEREAS, this request is in accordance with state and local laws governing Agricultural and Forestal Districts; and

WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee; and


WHEREAS, after conducting a duly advertised public hearing, the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee recommended the parcels be placed in the Pamunkey River Agricultural and Forestal District and voted 6:0:0 with a favorable recommendation of this application, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission scheduled and conducted a formal and duly advertised public hearing in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Code of Virginia, carefully considering the public comments received; and voted 6:0:1 to forward a favorable recommendation; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, this 14th day of October 2014, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors, the proposed agricultural and forestal application for the addition of tax map parcels 12-27 and 23-7 containing approximately 711 acres to the Pamunkey River Agricultural and Forestal District is hereby approved.
