**A RESOLUTION TO ADD A NEW BUSINESS MEETING AGENDA ITEM
ENTITLED "SMALL BUSINESS CLOSE UP" TO HIGHLIGHT AND PROMOTE
LOCAL BUSINESSES WITHIN NEW KENT COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors recognizes the importance of the business community by providing services for the citizens and tax revenues for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Community Development has proposed adding a new agenda item to the Board of Supervisors' business meeting agendas to spotlight local businesses within the County; and

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors is in favor of promoting local businesses throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the new agenda item entitled "Small Business Close Up" will be scheduled on a rotating basis amongst the five election districts, beginning with District 1 followed by Districts 2,3,4,5 and then back to District 1; and

WHEREAS, the new agenda item entitled "Small Business Close Up" will be placed on the regular business meeting agenda of the New Kent County Board of Supervisors at their April 2015 meeting and will continue thereafter at every business meeting or until such a time the Board of Supervisors determines it is no longer beneficial;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors this 9th day of March that a new agenda item be added to their business meetings entitled "Small Business Close Up" in order to highlight and promote local businesses within the County.
