Motion was made by Mr. Sparks, which carried 5:0, to adopt the following ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AN INCREASE IN THE
COSTS ASSESSED IN CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC CASES
FOR THE FUNDING OF COURTHOUSE SECURITY PERSONNEL**

WHEREAS, the *Code of Virginia, 1950*, has been amended to increase the amount that counties may assess against defendants convicted of a criminal or traffic offense in the district or circuit court of the County from five dollars (\$5.00) to ten dollars (\$10.00) effective July 1, 2007; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of New Kent believes it to be in the best interest of the County to increase the fee it assesses in order to assist with the cost of courtroom security;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of New Kent that:

Pursuant to *Code of Virginia* § 53.1-120, a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) shall be imposed as a part of court costs upon any defendant convicted in any criminal or traffic case in the district or circuit courts of the County. The fee shall be collected by the clerk of the court, who will remit the fee to the Treasurer of New Kent County. The Treasurer shall hold such fees subject to appropriation by the Board of Supervisors to the Sheriff's office for the funding of courthouse security personnel.

This ordinance shall become a part of the Code of New Kent County as Chapter 22 § 22-3 and be reflected in Appendix A, effective July 1, 2007.
