**A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION AFD-002-16
FOR THE ADDITION OF TAX MAP PARCEL 9-37
TO THE BLACK CREEK AGRICULTURAL AND FORESTAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Broyhill Foundation, Inc., has applied to add tax map parcel 9-37, totaling approximately 977 acres, of which 977 acres have been identified as agricultural and forestal significant to the Black Creek Agricultural and Forestal District; and

WHEREAS, granting this request will increase the acreage of the Black Creek Agricultural and Forestal District from its current 1,517 acres; and

WHEREAS, this request is in accordance with state and local laws governing Agricultural and Forestal Districts; and

WHEREAS, this application was thoroughly considered by the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, after conducting a duly advertised public hearing on April 21, 2016, the Agricultural and Forestal District Advisory Committee voted 8:0 to forward a favorable recommendation of this application to the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission scheduled and conducted a formal and duly advertised public hearing on June 20, 2016, in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Code of Virginia, carefully considering the public comments received and voted 9:0:1 to forward a favorable recommendation to the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this the 11th day of July, 2016, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors, the proposed agricultural and forestal application for the addition of tax map parcel 9-37 containing approximately 977 acres to the Black Creek Agricultural and Forestal District is hereby approved.
