Motion was made by Mr. Hill , which carried 4:0:1, to adopt the following Ordinance:

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
AMENDING § 70-54(b) OF
THE CODE OF NEW KENT COUNTY
FOR THE PURPOSE OF WAIVING THE ANNUAL LICENSE TAX
FOR CERTAIN VEHICLES REGISTERED TO ACTIVE MEMBERS
OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT OR RESCUE SQUAD
OR TO AN AUXILIARY DEPUTY SHERIFF**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that the license tax on certain passenger vehicles, pick-up or panel trucks registered to an active member of the volunteer fire department or rescue squad, and auxiliary deputy sheriffs, should be waived; and

WHEREAS, § 46.2 – 752 of the Code of Virginia, permits New Kent County to grant such a waiver; and

WHEREAS, the due date for the payment of the county's annual vehicle license tax begins the first week in November; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors by recorded motion has previously expressed its intent that such a waiver be granted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this, the 1st day of November, 2004, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors by authority granted to it under §§ 46.2-744 and 46.2-752 of the Code of Virginia that § 70-54 (b) of the New Kent County Code be amended and reenacted to provide as follows:

Sec. 70-54. Amount of annual license tax for classes of vehicles.

(b) The license tax on such passenger vehicle, pick-up or panel truck registered to (i) a member of the national guard and bearing national guard license plates shall be one-half of the fee applicable to the type of vehicle license ~~or, (ii) and the license tax for~~ a member of a volunteer fire department or rescue squad or (ii) ~~to~~ for an auxiliary deputy sheriff, shall be waived. ~~one-half of the fee applicable to the type of vehicle license.~~ The chief administrative officer of the volunteer fire department or volunteer rescue squad, or the Sheriff of New Kent County in the case of auxiliary deputy sheriffs, shall send to the treasurer a verified list of active members or auxiliary deputy sheriffs, one month before vehicle licenses go on sale in order for a member or auxiliary deputy sheriff to qualify. Each active member or auxiliary deputy sheriff shall be entitled to the waived fee for one vehicle only.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
