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Motion was made by Mr. Hill, which carried 5:0 to adopt the following emergency ordinance:

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO REMOVE A PARCEL ERRONEOUSLY  
INCLUDED IN THE BOTTOMS BRIDGE SERVICE DISTRICT BY AMENDING  
ATTACHMENT B TO ORDINANCE NO. O-05-04**

**WHEREAS**, at its regular meetings on April 13, 2004 and July 12, 2004, the Board of Supervisors of New Kent County, Virginia established the Bottoms Bridge Service District (the "Service District"); and

**WHEREAS**, it has been discovered that Tax Parcel No. 30-5 (the "Parcel") was erroneously included within the Service District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parcel is geographically distant from the Service District and the Parcel's owner does not wish to have it included in the Service District; and

**WHEREAS**, an emergency exists due to rapidly evolving plans and improvements in the Service District and the need to have a complete and accurate list of the parcels included within the Service District;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** under the authority granted pursuant to the Service Districts Act § 15.2-2400 *et. seq.* of the Code of Virginia, the Board of Supervisors hereby amends Attachment B to Ordinance No. O-05-04 to remove Tax Parcel No. 30-5 from the Service District as follows:
