Motion was made by Mr. Lockwood, which carried 5:0, to adopt the following resolution:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE NEW  
KENT COUNTY CODE (FEE SCHEDULE) TO CHANGE  
CERTAIN FEES CHARGED FOR COUNTY SERVICES  
(PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITY RENTAL AND  
COURTS) UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN THE  
CODE OF VIRGINIA**

**WHEREAS**, the County of New Kent imposes parks and recreation facility rental fees in accordance with 15.2-1806 of the code of Virginia; and

**WHEREAS**, some fees must be increased so that taxpayers would not have to bear the sole costs of paying for the upkeep of these rental facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Virginia General Assembly action (Virginia Code 53.1-120) during the 2020 session increased the assessment for courthouse security personnel, equipment and other personal property to not exceed twenty dollars (\$20.00) as part of the costs in each criminal or traffic case in its district or circuit court in which the defendant is convicted of a violation of any statute or ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the previous assessment limit for Courthouse security personnel, equipment, and other personal property was ten dollars (\$10.00); and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the New Kent County Board of Supervisors pursuant to the authority granted in the Code of Virginia, that the current Appendix A Fees be amended as follows:


