Motion was made by Mr. Burrell, which carried 5:0, to adopt the following Ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR  
TO ENTER INTO A  
JOINT POWERS ASSOCIATION AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the County of New Kent has been a participating member of the Community Criminal Justice Board for Colonial Community Corrections for many years and had previously entered a Joint Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly enacted laws that had to be incorporated into the previously entered Joint Powers Agreement for the provision of community corrections services to the residents of New Kent; and

**WHEREAS**, the participating jurisdictions agreed to amend their Joint Powers Agreement and to rename the organization to The Colonial Community Criminal Justice Board; and

**WHEREAS**, political subdivisions of the Commonwealth of Virginia are authorized under Virginia law to exercise jointly powers that they otherwise are authorized to exercise independently, and the terms and conditions of such authorization are currently set forth in Sections 15.2-1300, et seq. of the Virginia Code (the "Joint Powers Act"); and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** that:

1. The Joint Powers Agreement and the performance of the terms and conditions thereof on behalf of the County of New Kent are hereby authorized and approved.

2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Joint Powers Agreement on behalf of the County of New Kent that is attached to this Ordinance and made part of the record of the Board of Supervisors.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption or passage.
