Sec. 9-83 Uses permitted by conditional use permit only.


Construction business, with storage of equipment, as a home occupation.

Distillation of ethanol from grain.


Equestrian Show Facility.

General Store. Any retail establishment offering for sale items of a general mercantile nature including food and beverage products, household, and hardware items. Such store shall not have underground tanks or pumps for dispensing fuel for on-road vehicles. Such store shall be restricted to 3,000 square feet or less of retail sales floor. Such establishment shall be restricted to existing structures with historical general mercantile use. The term shall not include truck stops, nor shall be used for any activity commonly associated with truck stops such as storing, maintaining, or parking trucks and other commercial vehicles overnight.
