

A WORK SESSION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF NEW KENT COUNTY WAS HELD ON THE TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF OCTOBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED NINETY IN THE LOWER CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT. CHAIRMAN E. DAVID RINGLEY PRESIDED.

IN RE: REVIEW OF COURTHOUSE RENOVATION PROJECT WITH ARCHITECT

The County Administrator, Mr. Hart, introduced Mr. Louis A. Austin, Jr., AIA, of the MMM Design Group. Mr. George Wilson and Mr. Charles Sweitzer of the same firm were also in attendance. Mr. Austin gave a presentation to the Board of Supervisors on the work done to date on the courthouse renovation project. Following a lengthy discussion, a meeting of the architect with the courthouse users was scheduled for November 14th at 10:30 a.m., in the Large Conference Room. The judge, the sheriff, the Commonwealth's attorney, and the clerks of court agreed to meet at 8 a.m. prior to consultation with the architect. The information determined from that meeting will be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors.

IN RE: 1991 LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE

The Chairman opened discussion of the 1991 Legislative Package. The Board reviewed Item 1 and took action as follows: Mr. Robinson moved to include in the package the Board's expression of support for legislation which would allow local collection of a one-half cent local sales tax.

The Board continued their review of items to be included in the legislative package, made changes, and gave direction to the County Attorney and the County Administrator concerning the formation of the package.

IN RE: WATER AND SEWER STUDY

The County Administrator asked to discuss the water and sewer study. The Administrator informed the Board that, although the scope of the study had been reduced, the price for the study had not decreased considerably, and therefore the Administrator recommended that the Board direct staff to issue invitations to bid for: (1) Preparation of a construction design manual; (2) Compile an existing septic system inventory; and (3) Perform modeling studies on all existing water systems not previously modeled. Following a discussion, the Board authorized the Administrator to issue the invitations to bid.
