

A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE PLANNING COMMISSION HELD ON THE TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT, IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE NEW KENT COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING, NEW KENT, VIRGINIA. THE VICE-CHAIRMAN OPENED THE MEETING WITH ALL PRESENT EXCEPT MR. ROBINSON.

IN RE: PUBLIC HEARING - PRINT SHOP ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

Mr. Marvin Bradby, Chairman of Joint Public Hearings, opened the duly advertised public hearing on an amendment to the zoning ordinance to include print shops as a permitted use in the B-1, general business district.

Mr. Frederick Bates presented the Staff's recommendation for the amendment. He explained that the Planning Commission had voted to recommend for its approval at the April 25th meeting.

Mrs. Thelma Wilson spoke in favor of the amendment.

Mr. Ellyson asked that a definition of a "print shop" be included in the amendment.

There being no further comments, Mr. Bradby closed the public hearing.
