

A WORK SESSION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON THE FIRST DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD, NINETEEN HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING, NEW KENT, VIRGINIA. THE CHAIRMAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

IN RE: STREET NAME SYSTEM

The Board entered into a general discussion on the County-wide street naming system. Following discussion, the Board instructed the staff to prepare a corrected list and map for each of the Board members prior to the August 8, 1988, regular Board meeting.

IN RE: SEPTIC TANK FEES

The Chairman of the Board requested that the Board consider discussing the issue of septic fees charged by both the County and the State. Motion was made by Mr. Boroughs to consider the septic tank fee issue and carried as follows:

The Board entered into a discussion concerning the fact that based on emergency legislation adopted by the State of Virginia, now both the State and the County were collecting a fee for well and septic tank applications. The Board reviewed the staff report prepared for the regular August 8th meeting and motion was made by Mr. Boroughs to instruct the County Administrator, as emergency action, to instruct the office of Public Safety to stop collecting any fee for well and septic tank applications, to advise all citizens applying for these permits to apply at the local State Health Department Office, and that all fees collected from citizens by the County who had also paid the State fee, receive a refund from the County. Motion carried as follows:
