## Notice of At-large Director Vacancy

The Colonial Soil and Water Conservation District (District), a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, is seeking a qualified candidate to fill the position of At Large member on the District's Board of Directors, commencing on January 1, 2023, and ending December 31, 2026.

The District serves the jurisdictions of Charles City, James City, New Kent, Williamsburg, and York by promoting voluntary conservation initiatives aimed at improving local soil and water resources through offerings of technical and financial assistance. District Board members are expected to:

- Identify soil and water issues and opportunities within the district or related to the district and establish priorities for addressing these issues.
- Seek a comprehensive understanding of the complex issues that impact soil and water and assist in resolving the identified issues at the watershed, local, regional, state, and national levels.
- Engage in actions that will improve soil and water stewardship by use of locally led programs.
- Increase understanding among community leaders, including elected officials and others, of their role in soil and water quality protection and improvement.
- Foster discussion and advancement within the community of positions and programs by their district.
- Actively participate in the activities of the district and ensure district resources are used effectively and managed wisely.
- Support and promote the advancement of districts and their capabilities.

District Board members do not receive compensation for their position.

Persons interested in applying for the vacant Board position must submit a letter of intent stating their desire, qualifications, and reasons for wanting to serve on the District Board. Letters must be received no later than Friday September 30<sup>th</sup>. Interviews of qualified candidates will be scheduled before October 21<sup>st</sup>.
